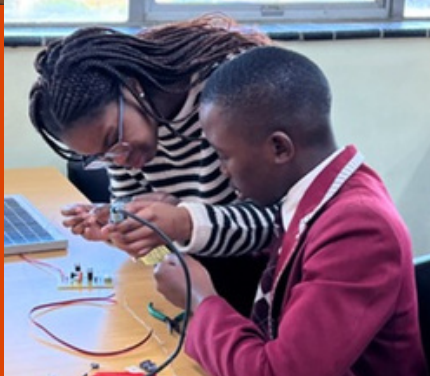


ABOUT US

TRANSFORMATIVE SOCIAL WORK



This rapidly changing landscape requires universities to be more agile in responding to critical challenges while preparing students to make a positive impact on society.

SU, according to its Vision 2040, wants to be Africa's "leading research university, globally recognised as excellent, inclusive, and innovative," and "where knowledge is advanced in the service of society".

The short course comprises of the following modules:

CRITICAL THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



This module facilitates engaging the world in a critical way, through questioning the dominant narrative and evaluating personal assumptions and bias. Participants are provided with different lenses to evaluate whether information is factual when formulating a personal opinion.

AGILITY AND ADAPTABILITY



In a rapidly changing world, skills such as flexibility and adaptability are invaluable, especially as we find ourselves faced with growing societal issues and uncertainty across the globe. Through this module, you will be challenged to become cognisant of rigid thinking and the benefits of journeying beyond your comfort zones.

COLLABORATION ACROSS NETWORKS AND LEADING BY INFLUENCE



This module discusses the concepts of collaboration and leadership. You'll be encouraged to lead by influence and to identify potential opportunities for collaboration.

CURIOSITY AND IMAGINATION



Curiosity plays an important role in awakening our imagination. Through this module, you will be encouraged to explore and reimagine a more just world for all who live in it.
